

# Class Creation

<b>Grade Level</b>	10th-12th

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## Class Description

This class will give students an in depth study of the Romantic and Victorian eras of literature in England during the 1800s. We will explore the worldview of each of the author's studied in light of the historical happenings in England at that time. Focus will be given to the sub genre of Gothic fiction and literary analysis of each of the novels studied. Students should expect between 3-5 hours of homework a week along with weekly reading quizzes, papers, and possible projects. Since this is primarily a discussion based class, class participation is a MUST. Worth 1 high school credit in English. Students will read between 5-6 novels through the course of the co-op year.

I have not been able to find a suitable textbook that I like for British literature so I will be writing my own lesson plans while using supplemental activities from Teachers Pay Teachers. Possible novels to be considered (final list will be decided after sign-ups) will be Frankenstein, Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde, Pride and Prejudice, A Christmas Carol, and Northanger Abbey.

## Text/Materials

Once a list of novels to be studied is created, students will need to purchase them.
