Class Description	<p>Using Lee Giles' Comparative Government for the first semester, in addition to a Modern States CLEP Prep Review course, students will learn about the United States government, its primary documents, and its different branches. (We will do the first 90 days of the 180 day course; students may finish the other (international government) half of the course at home if they choose.) Students who opt to take the CLEP exam may count the course as Honors credit.</p> <p>In the second semester, students will use Oikonomia: Economics for Life and Flourishing at home (flipped classroom style) and participate in group activities, games, and discussions in our live class. While this is not a writing course, students should be prepared and comfortable to write short essays and reports periodically throughout the semester. This course will work best for students who have already had a U. S. History course. Please look through the linked programs to make sure this course is a good fit for your student. I will keep track of points in the course, but parents will assign final grades and / or high school credit for transcript purposes. I'm excited about teaching it!</p>
