Class Description	<p>Being an effective communicator is a non-negotiable skill that all of us need to develop. This class will seek to develop that skill through the preparation of 4 given speeches: Self-Introduction, Narrative, Descriptive, and Persuasive. While teaching these 4 types of speeches, students will gain practice and understanding in elocution, eye contact, hand gestures, etc. Depending on class size and time, students will also gain skills in debating and spontaneous speech making.</p> <p>This class is limited to only 6 students per class to ensure enough time for all students on speech days, but it is being offered both semesters to accommodate more students. The first 6 students will be in the fall class. The next 6 students will be in the spring class.</p> <p>This class will count as ½ high school credit.</p>
